### Our PAW-rific Week In Review!

Students completed GCPS Beginning of the Year Pretests in Math, Art, and Spanish.

**Language Arts** – Students read an informational piece about the largest rodent in the world...the capybara! Then, they wrote a fictional piece with a capybara as the main character for their Beginning of the Year Writing Test. We also began our Mentor Sentence (grammar) program and had our first Mentor Sentence Test. We learned the five parts of a friendly letter and wrote to our parents. We are learning how to be CLOSE Readers for greater comprehension. Students should be reading 150 minutes a week at home and recording their books on their yellow Bingo card located in their red Reading Folder. I loved reading the book reviews this week!

<u>Math-</u> We learned about place value to the millions. We also had a Multiplication Minute quiz. We will repeat these quizzes throughout each quarter. Only the top 3 scores for your child will be recorded in the grade book by the end of the 9 weeks. Please keep practicing at home with flash cards and/or e-flash cards.

<u>Science-</u> We began our study of the Water Cycle. We learned that the **water cycle** is the constant movement of water through the Earth and its atmosphere. We also did a fun science experiment to learn how easily germs can be spread.

**Social Studies**- We began learning about the geography of the United States. Next week, we will learn how six different Native American tribes in different regions of the country adapted to their environments.

#### <u>A Peek at Next Week</u> I Can...

**Language Arts** – write a summary that includes key points about characters, important events, and the problem and solution.

Math – recognize & demonstrate place value in multi-digit number. - make sense in word problems and preserve in solving them.

**Social Studies** – locate Atlantic Coastal Plain, Great Plains, Continental Divide, the Great Basin, Death Valley, Gulf of Mexico, St. Lawrence River, and the Great Lakes

**Science** – demonstrate and explain the Water Cycle and the roles of evaporation, condensation, and precipitation.
