## Our PAW-rific Week In Review!

**Language Arts** – We read a story in reading groups called, “How Bad Could It Be,” which was about a boy who learned that he needed to choose his friends wisely. Students analyzed how the character changed from the beginning to the end of the story. We also reviewed suffixes, base words, compound sentences, and much more!

**Math**- Students did a great job on their Addition/Subtraction math test! We began our next unit, Multiplication and Division. We constructed a mult/division chart, learned what factors and multiples are, and created area models to solve multiplication problems. Thank you for helping your child with their math homework.
