Our PAW-rific Week In Review!

<u>Language Arts</u> – This week we wrote quick personal narratives in our Writer's Notebook about various topics, reviewed vivacious verbs, the prefixes im- & in-, and possessive & plural nouns. The students are doing a great job turning boring sentences into "Beautiful Sentences," and they are writing excellent summaries on eclass!

<u>Math-</u> Students are learning how to estimate sums and differences by rounding large numbers **before** computation. We are also learning how to write expressions using unknown variables. We began multiplying multi-digit numbers to preview our next unit. Thank you for helping your child with their math homework.

<u>Social Studies</u>- We began our unit on European Explorers with a lesson on what it means to be an explorer and the limited technology we had in the 1400s to assist in exploration. Students began working in teams to research an assigned explorer. We will continue our research next week and make posters to present to the class next week. This project will be completed at school, but students can print pictures and maps at home to add to their poster.

<u>Science-</u> We are learning how to read a weather map. Students learned about fronts and the various symbols meteorologists use to forecast the weather.
