Our PAW-rific Week In Review!

<u>Language Arts</u> – We reviewed strategies for Close Reading by writing our thoughts on the text as we read. Students will begin using sticky notes to take notes as they read their chapter books at home. Students created fun, imaginative stories and illustrations through our Squiggle Writing activity.

<u>Math-</u> We continued practicing strategies to add & subtract large numbers, solve word problems, find the value of variables, and analyze errors in computation. We will have our Unit 2 Test on Wednesday. Answers (for parents) to the study guide will be posted on our website. Thank you for helping your child with their math homework. We will begin Division Minutes in October.

<u>Social Studies</u>- Students enjoyed researching their explorers and creating posters to present to their classmates. Many groups have also created amazing PowerPoints to assist with their presentations!

<u>Science</u> This week we reviewed the various instruments that scientists use to measure temperature, humidity, air pressure, and wind. We also introduced various fronts and the weather that each front brings with it. We performed a neat experiment with a water balloon and a jar to demonstrate air pressure. Ask your child all about it!

A Peek at Next Week

I Can...

Language Arts – use prefixes, suffixes, and base words to help understand the meaning of words in a text.

Math – find strategies to multiply large numbers.
